

TOWN COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS

OCTOBER 17, 2016

JACKSON, WYOMING

The Jackson Town Council met in workshop session in the Council Chambers of the Town Hall at 150 East Pearl at 3:00 P.M. Upon roll call the following were found to be present:

MAYOR: Sara Flitner

COUNCIL: Hailey Morton Levinson, Bob Lenz, Don Frank, and Jim Stanford.

STAFF: Bob McLaurin, Audrey Cohen-Davis, Lea Colasuonno, Roxanne Robinson, Larry Pardee, Tyler Sinclair, Alex Norton, and Sandy Birdyshaw

2017 Rodeo Dates and Rodeo Report. Roxanne Robinson presented proposed rodeo dates for 2017, pointing out that the June 24th date conflicts with the World Series of Team Roping event. The Council had the option of keeping the rodeo on June 24th or removing it from the schedule. Public comment was given by Phillip Wilson and Brandon Wilson of Jackson Hole Rodeo, Fair Manager Kaitlyn Mangis, Pete Feuz, Emily Feuz Beardsley of the Fair Board, and Jason Wheeldon.

A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Don Frank to approve the rodeo schedule for 2017 as presented, minus the June 24 date so options, including alternative parking, may be explored between the concessionaire and Teton County; to accept the 2016 Rodeo Season Operations Report into the record; and continue the requested amendments to the concession agreement to the November 21st Town Council meeting. Mayor Flitner called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried.

District 2 Discussion. Tyler Sinclair made staff comment and offered three options to the Council for moving forward with the regulations. Option 1) To return to the previous regulations. Option 2) To readopt the Character District 2 – Town Commercial Core zoning removing the Short Term Rental Workforce Housing Incentive Tool. Option 3) Begin a new Character District 2 – Town Commercial Core zoning district public process.

Public comment was given by Brenda Wylie representing Johnson Resort Properties, Matt Kim Miller representing Teton Brewing Company, Armond Acri, Judd Grossman, Mary Gibson of the Jackson Hole Conservation Alliance, and Scott Pierson of Pierson LandWorks.

The Council discussed the three options and there was general consensus toward option 2. No motion was made on this item.

Adjourn. A motion was made by Hailey Morton Levinson and seconded by Bob Lenz to adjourn the meeting to executive session to consider matters concerning litigation to which the governing body is a party or proposed litigation to which the governing body may be a party in accordance with Wyoming Statute 16-4-405(a)(iii). Mayor Flitner called for the vote. The vote showed all in favor. The motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 4:15 P.M.
