

**PROCLAMATION**  
**2016**  
**FALL CLEAN-UP AND FALL BURN WEEK**

WHEREAS, it is customary in the fall of each year to declare a burn week for citizens of the Town of Jackson to use controlled burns to clean up their property by burning only clean wood, branches and leaves; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Jackson and Teton County Integrated Solid Waste and Recycling have partnered for the Second Annual Fall Clean-Up with the common goal to encourage residents to divert yard waste from the trash stream so that it may be composted locally rather than hauled to the landfill; and

WHEREAS, citizens may use free compostable bags to collect their yard waste that are available at Town Hall and the Recycling Center; and

WHEREAS, residents wishing to participate in the **Fall Clean-Up** may drop off their yard waste at the Rodeo Grounds on **November 4<sup>th</sup> through November 6<sup>th</sup>** from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.; and

WHEREAS, Residents are also encouraged to participate in the **Great Pumpkin Round-Up**, a community event that enables citizens to drop off their jack-o-lanterns at the Rodeo Grounds to be composted on **November 5<sup>th</sup>** from 9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Sara Flitner, Mayor of the Town of Jackson, do hereby proclaim **November 5<sup>th</sup> through November 13<sup>th</sup>** as **Fall Burn Week** and remind persons who desire to burn, to contact the Jackson Hole Law Enforcement Agency at 733-2331 prior to burning; and

FURTHER, I designate **November 4<sup>th</sup> through November 6<sup>th</sup>** as **Fall Clean-Up** and encourage all citizens to participate in this significant Jackson event.
