



## -Redmond Street Rentals -

The lack of affordable housing in Teton County is real: the 2014 Housing Needs Assessment estimates that 1,200 affordable units are needed to meet the present demand for workforce housing.

- Currently less than 11% of the housing units in Teton County can be considered affordable.
- Less than 6% of all affordable units are rentals.
- 1,000 new employees will be needed to replace retiring workers in the next ten years.
- A dual income household earning median income in Teton County grosses \$86,000 annually and can afford a \$350,000 home. The cheapest home on the market today is \$550,000.
- Once constructed, **Redmond Street Rentals** will provide affordable rental homes for 55 members our community's workforce.
