

ORDINANCE A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REENACTING SECTION 1 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NOS. 1044, 636 AND 610, SECTION 21 OF TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCE NO. 131, RESOLUTION 04-27 AND SECTION 10.04.190 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON REGARDING PARKING LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION I.

Section 1 of Town of Jackson Ordinance Nos.1044, 636 and 610, Section 21 of Town of Jackson Ordinance No. 131, Resolution 04-27 and Section 10.04.190 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Jackson, are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

10.04.190 Parking time limited on Town streets.

A. 72 hour parking. No person shall park a vehicle or permit said vehicle to remain parked in the same block face on any street or alley within the Town of Jackson continuously for longer than seventy-two hours.

B. When appropriate signage, pavement markings or curb markings are erected or put in place by proper authority in each block giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle or permit said vehicle to remain parked for longer than the time specified between the hours shown upon any of the streets or part of streets described in Schedule 9 set out in Section 10.04.390 and made a part of this chapter.

SECTION II.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed as a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication.
