

ORDINANCE C

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING TOWN OF JACKSON ORDINANCES 1121, 1122, 1123, 1124, 1125, 1126, 1127, 1128 AND 1129 IN CONNECTION WITH IMPLEMENTING CHARACTER DISTRICT 2 – TOWN COMMERCIAL CORE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF JACKSON, WYOMING, IN REGULAR SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED, THAT:

SECTION I.

A referendum petition was received by the Town of Jackson on August 22, 2016 regarding Ordinances 1121, 1122, 1123, 1124, 1125, 1126, 1127, 1128 and 1129. After being certified as legally sufficient by the Town Clerk under W.S. 22-23-1006, Ordinance 1134 was passed on August 29 suspending the above ordinance until after Special Election occurred on September 20, 2016 on the referendum. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal the above ordinances as required by W.S. § 22-23-1006 because a majority of the electors voting on the question favored rejection. As such, the Town of Jackson does hereby repeal Town of Jackson Ordinances 1121, 1122, 1123, 1124, 1125, 1126, 1127, 1128 and 1129 in connection with implementing Character District 2 – Town Commercial Core.

SECTION II.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION III.

If any section, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION IV.

This Ordinance shall become effective after its passage, approval and publication.
